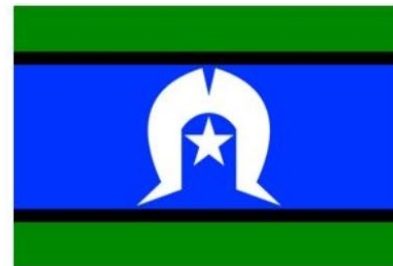

## Positive activity

- Introduction of the Fatal Hazard critical control verification activities for PGM.
- Critical control verification activities incorporated in current site activities such as workplace inspections, PTO and SAO's.
- Increased Visible Leadership interactions across the business.
- Introduction of "War on Dust" site program airborne dust best practice.
- All supervisors to undertake a minimum training to the level of RIWHS301D Conduct safety and health investigations.
- HPRI Improvements to be treated as a positive reporting, actions tracked for each HPRI via monthly reporting and reviewed by the Senior Leadership Team.
- Updated health monitoring program for employee's health and fitness.
- Compulsory alcohol testing continued for all workers entering site.
- Increased Mines Rescue Member and continued ERT cert 3 onsite training for team members

## COVID-19

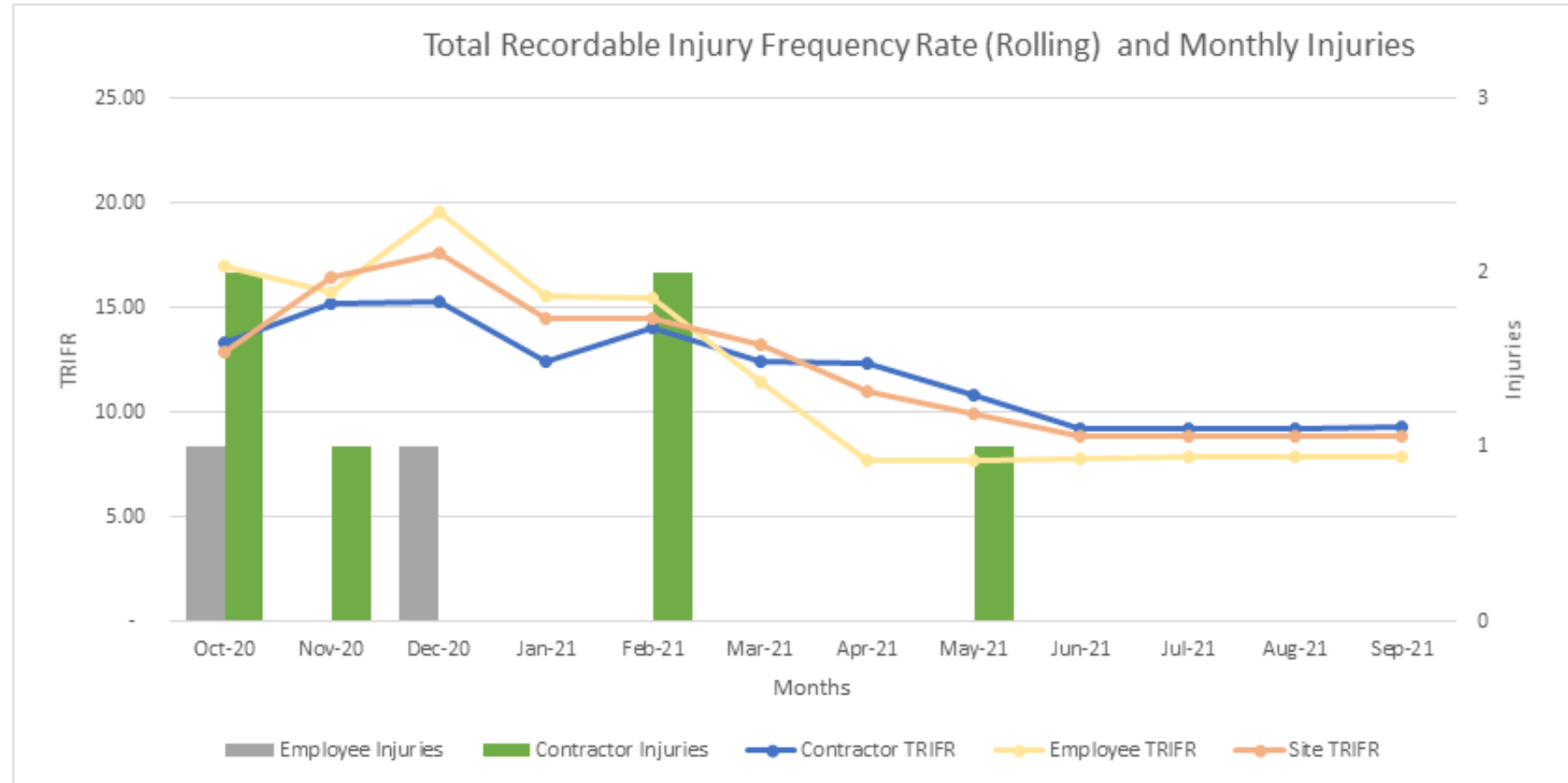
- Updating COVID-19 risk control and verification measures. Peak Gold Mine has re-enforced controls in the following key areas:
  - Social Distancing included limiting meetings, on-line meetings and scheduled activities.
  - Small and consistent workgroups being traceable.
  - Implemented COVID-19 Essential Services Duty Card.
  - Review and monitor lessons learnt from industry.
  - Introduction of the Rapid Antigen Testing process.
- Increased controls were applied to workers travelling from hot spot and lockdown areas.
  - Additional controls in line with the Aurelia Metals Pandemic Management Plan re-enforced across the site.
  - Implementation of the Contact Harold system at the mine site.
  - Onsite Rapid Antigen testing done on all workers first shift back.

## Lag indicators

- TRIFR Improvement Plan undertaking more stringent investigations and actions to endeavour in the prevention of recurring incidents.
- All actions are now managed through the INX system and are monitored regularly.
- More stringent management of NSW Resource Regulator issued notices.

## Environmental Incidents, Complaints & Initiatives – Jul 21 to Sept 21

### Environmental Incidents

- There were no environmental incidents requiring notification of environmental harm to the regulator during the period.

### Complaints

- Two complaints were received during the period regarding blast vibration:
  - A complaint was received on 12 July which correlated to a PGM blast. Monitoring data received from a blast monitor confirmed compliance with licence conditions.
  - A complaint received on 28 July did not align with the PGM blasting schedule.

### Environmental Initiatives

- The Pollution Incident Response Management Plan was updated in June and is available on the Aurelia website.
- The Annual Return for EPL 3596 was submitted in August.
- The National Pollution Inventory Report was submitted in September.

- Environmental Monitoring reports are available on the Aurelia website.

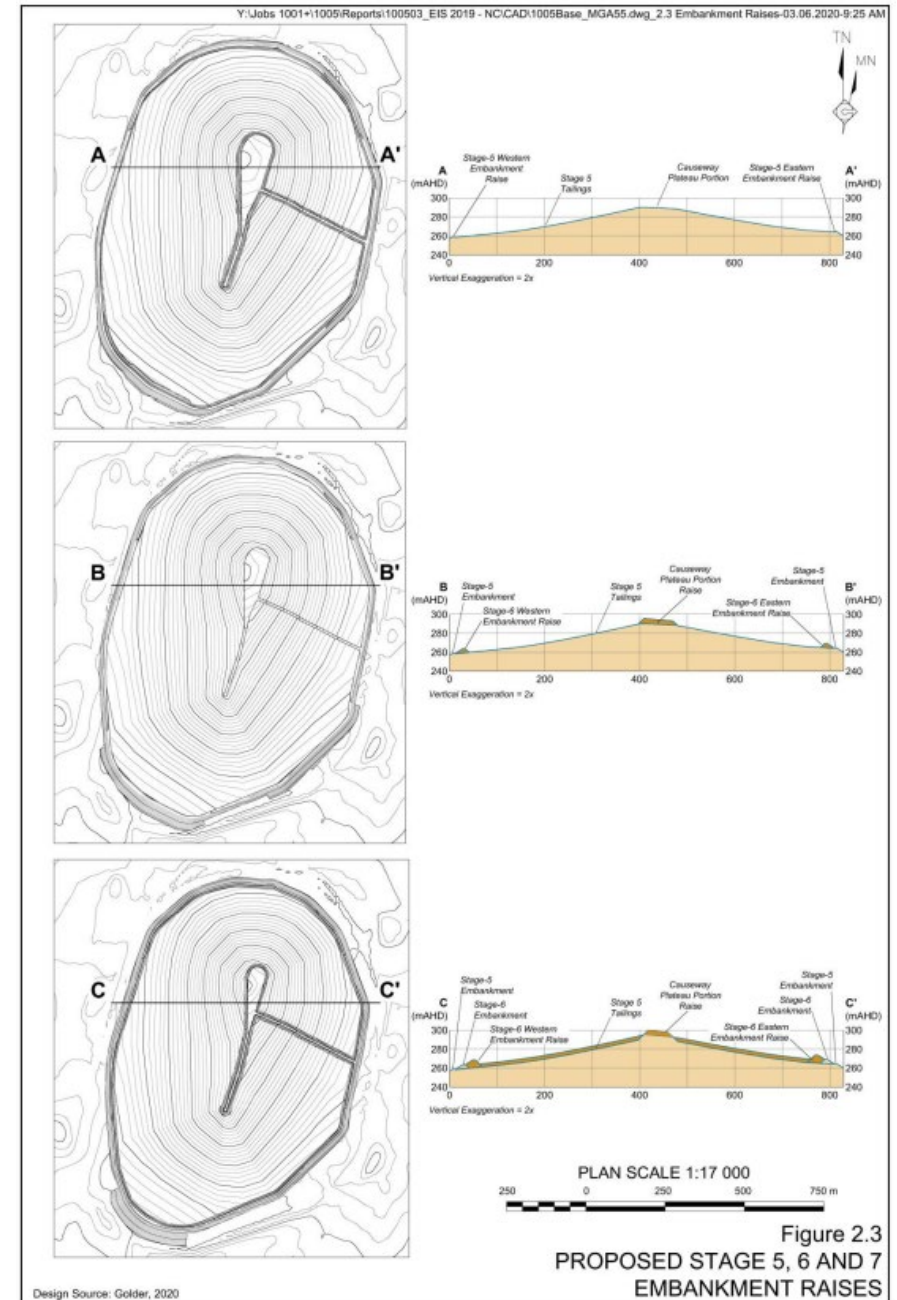
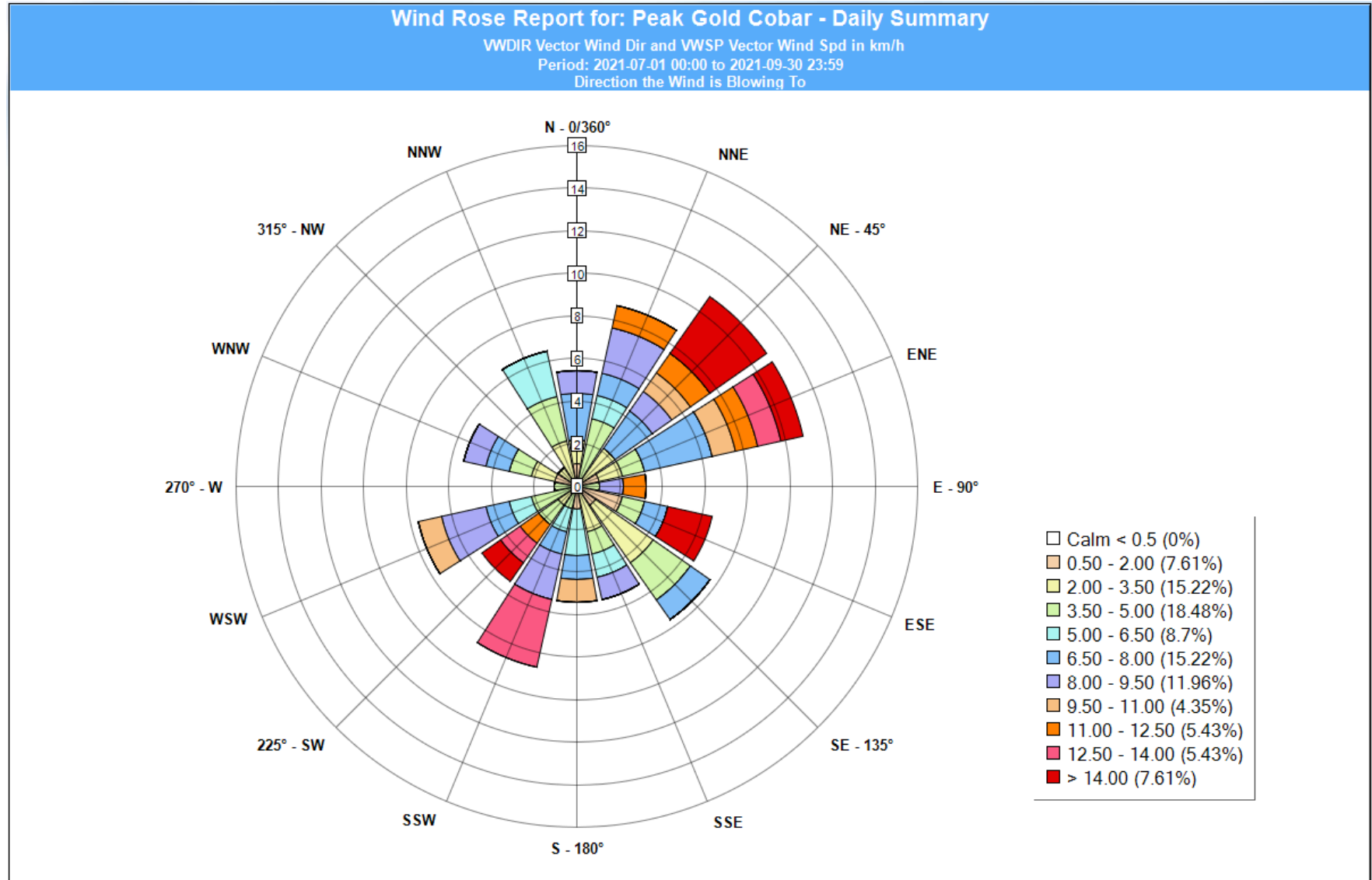

EMBANKMENT RAISES

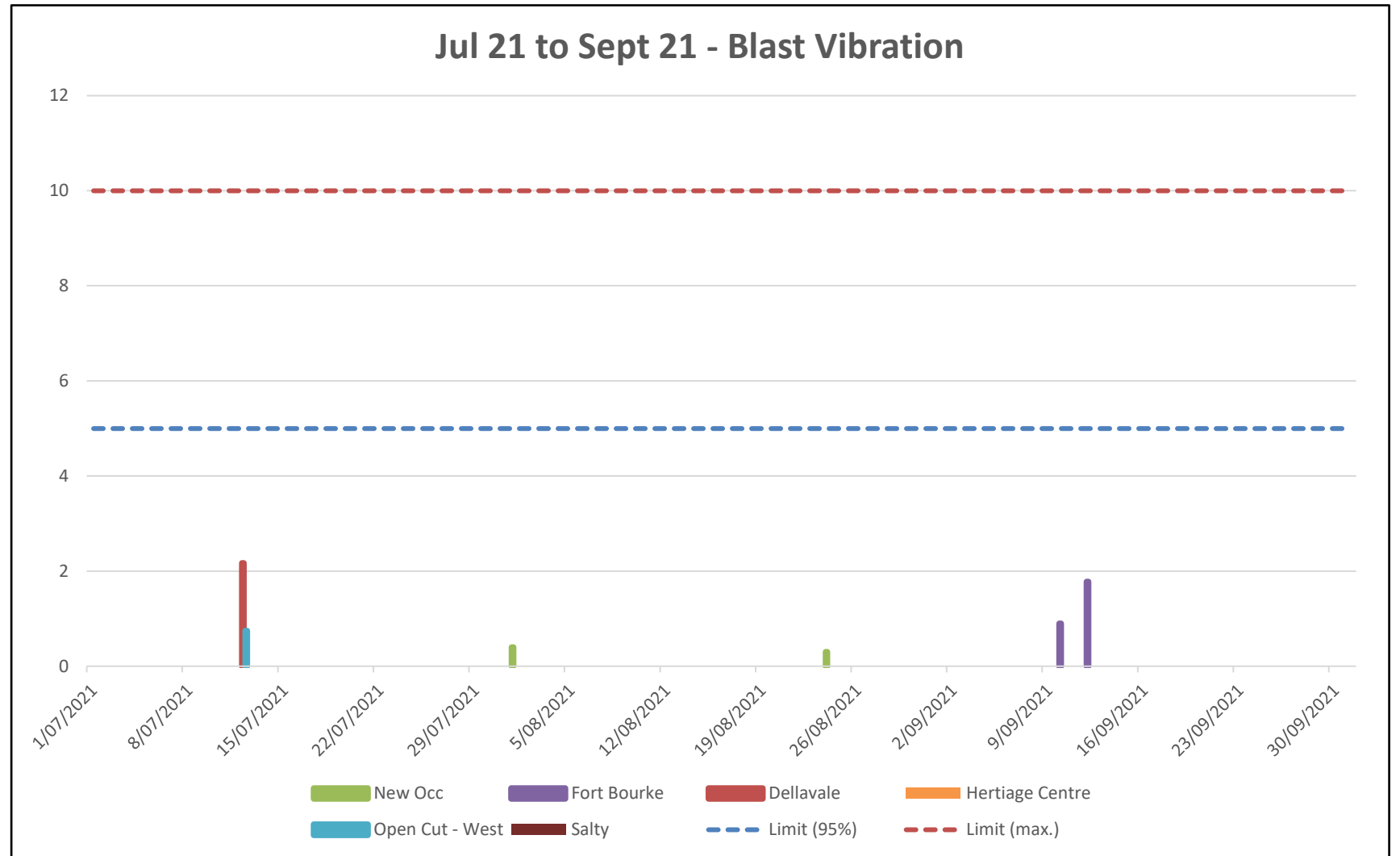

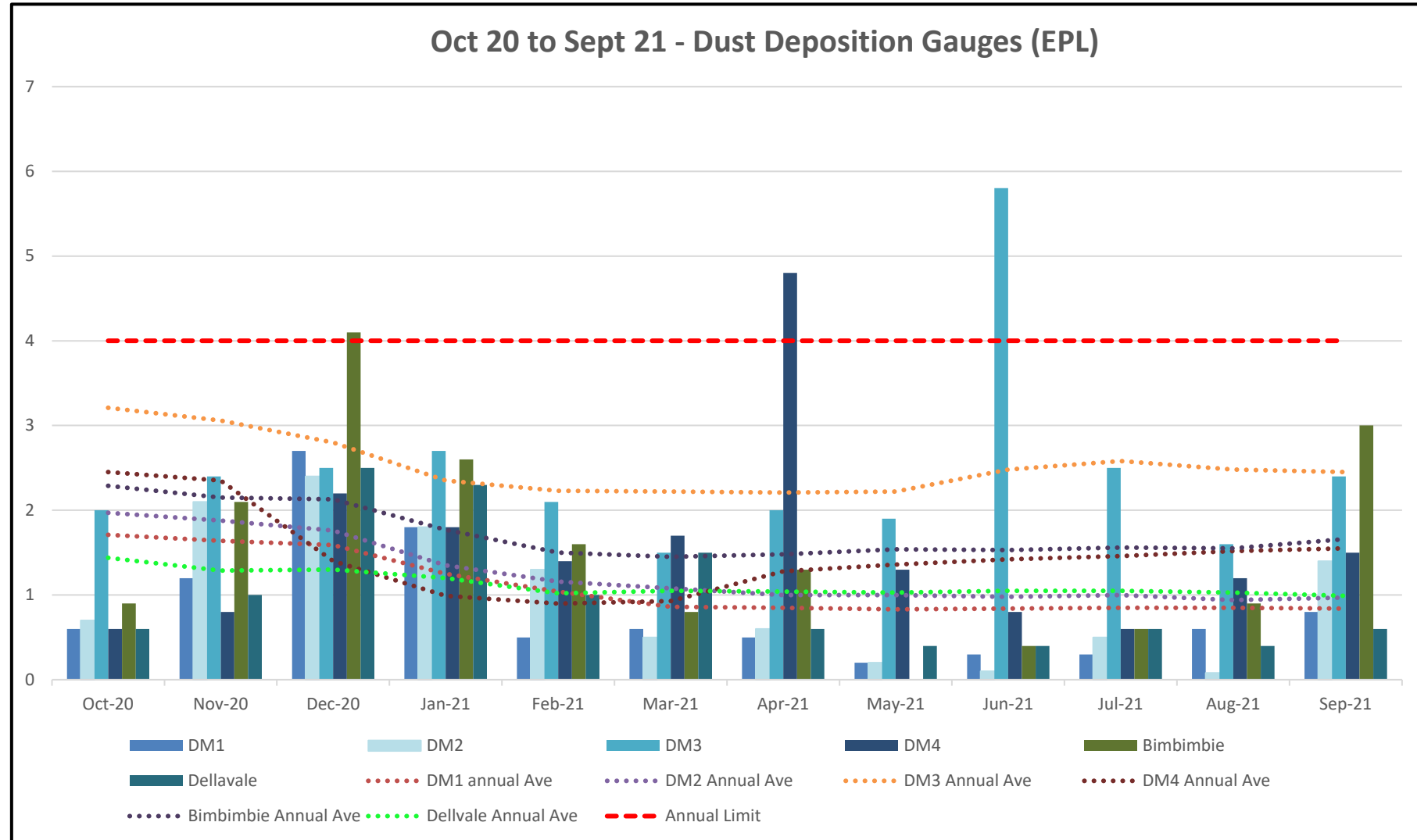

## Environmental Monitoring – Jul 21 to Sept 21



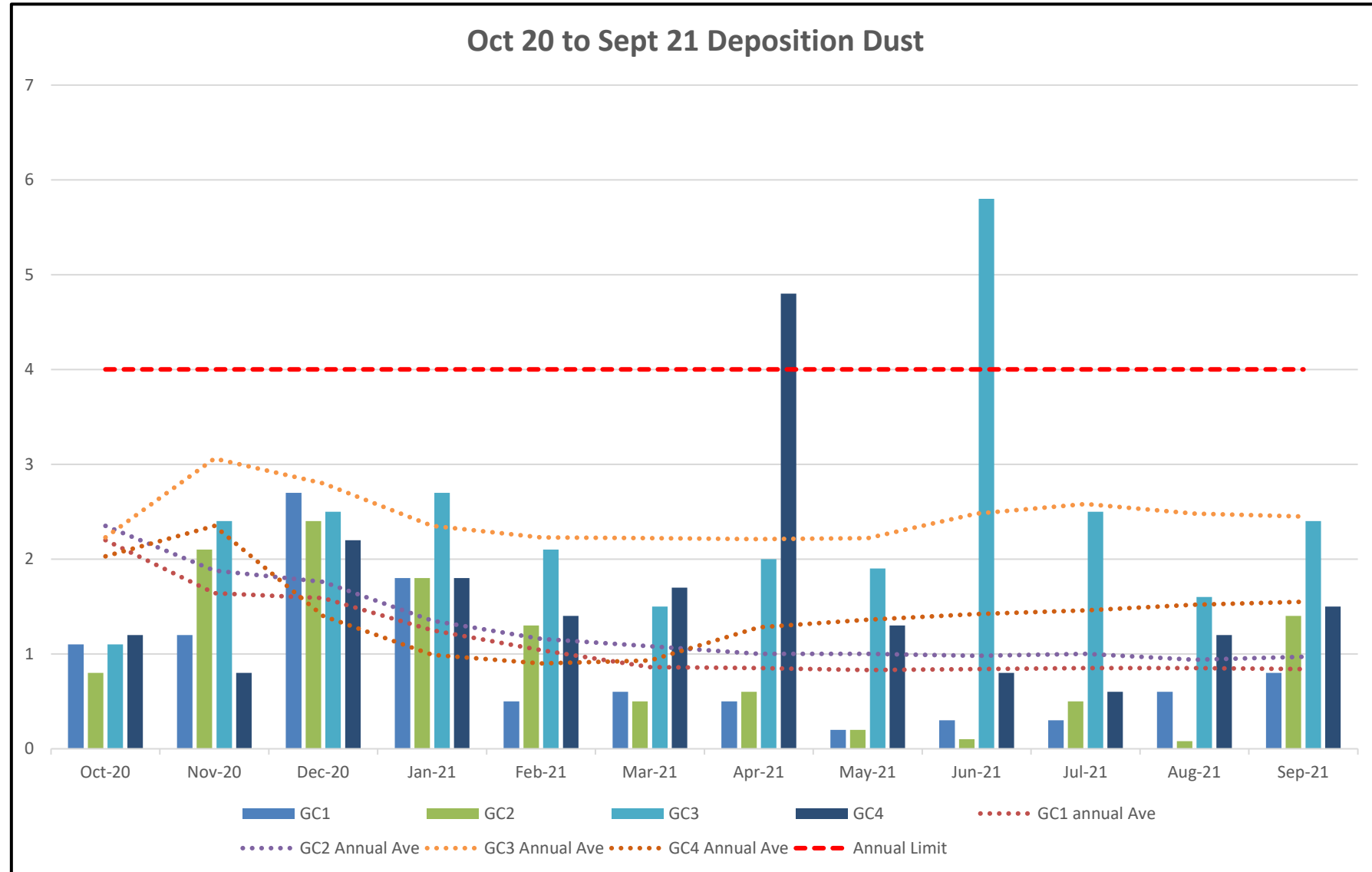

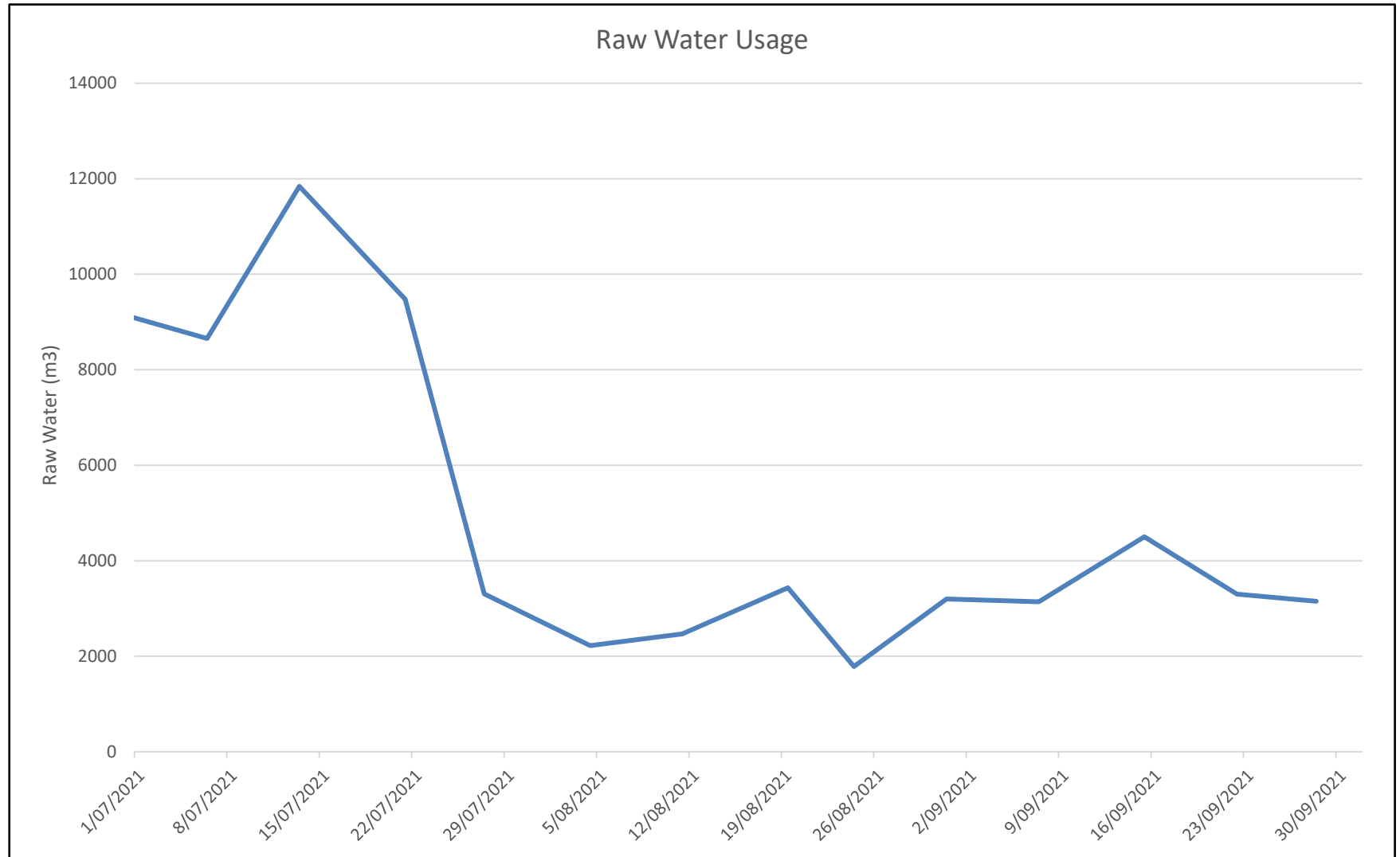
